The new children are nicely settling down with the older toddlers by watching & trying to immitate them. It is so nice to see how the older ones try to look after the younger ones.

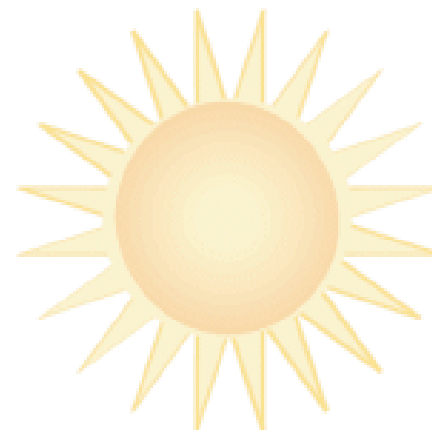
It is amazing to see how quickly the children absorb & learn what we teach them during our work time. This is the joy we receive as teachers.
